Brand Guidelines



Hi There.

We're Maya Del Sol

These guidelines are designed to help maintain consistency across the Maya Del Sol Brand. These should be shared and used by all stakeholders, including anyone who will be creating any sort of collateral for the brand.

There should be a strong focus around the use of the logo, colour and font. These are the 3 key parts which currently form the brand from a digital perspective.

Failure to adhere to the brand guidelines leads to inconsistencies and can create bad brand habits over time if not corrected.

Although it's preferential for the tan gold and white coloured logo to be used, occasionally the black and white versions will need to be. This is very often down to print restrictions or a third party's requirements when supplying the logo to them.

In this scenario, the logo, logotype or symbol must be used following the convention of using a light colour type on a dark background or in a dark colour type on a light background.

The full Maya Del Sol logotype and/or symbol colour must be clearly distinguishable from the background colour. The Maya Del Sol palette must be honoured whenever possible, using black or white if necessary.

To ensure a high resolution logo, we advise supplying a vector file format such as an EPS or AI when sending to a third party.



Identity Structure

The Maya Del Sol brand logo consists of the overarching company name, 'Maya Del Sol' as well as the descriptor 'Property Group'. It's important to maintain the balance and structure of the logo as illustrated here.



Brand Usage

The Maya Del Sol brand identity has been designed using flattering and complimentary colour combinations to provide brand flexibility. Here are the three different colour ways that can be used for the logo, when it's in colour. This is essential for brand consistency.

Minimum Size

When significantly reduced, the logo will become illegible. These are the pixel size units we recommend staying within to preserve the quality of the logo - failure to adhere to this may may impact the visibility of the logo.



Safe Zones

It's important to maintain proper spacing around the logo to avoid overcrowding. The use of whitespace keeps the brand feeling clean. We recommend a margin equal to the depth of both lines of type (marked X). Failure to adhere to this may make the logo look over crowded and busy.



Brand Identity

The Maya Del Sol logo is available in three formats, as shown below. The primary logo is to be used wherever possible to effectively represent the brand and create consistency.

Colour Palette



Colour Palette

The Maya Del Sol colour palette is colourful and positive with a touch of the bohemian in order to maintain the brand's approachable, yet professional and aspirational aesthetic.

When possible, marketing materials should be kept light, with type and design elements contrasted in one of the darker or warmer tones available. When using two of the brand colours together, be conscious of the contrast in order to maintain legibility.

The lighter shades shown are more important when used digitally than in print, as we want all marketing materials to meet high accessibility standards.

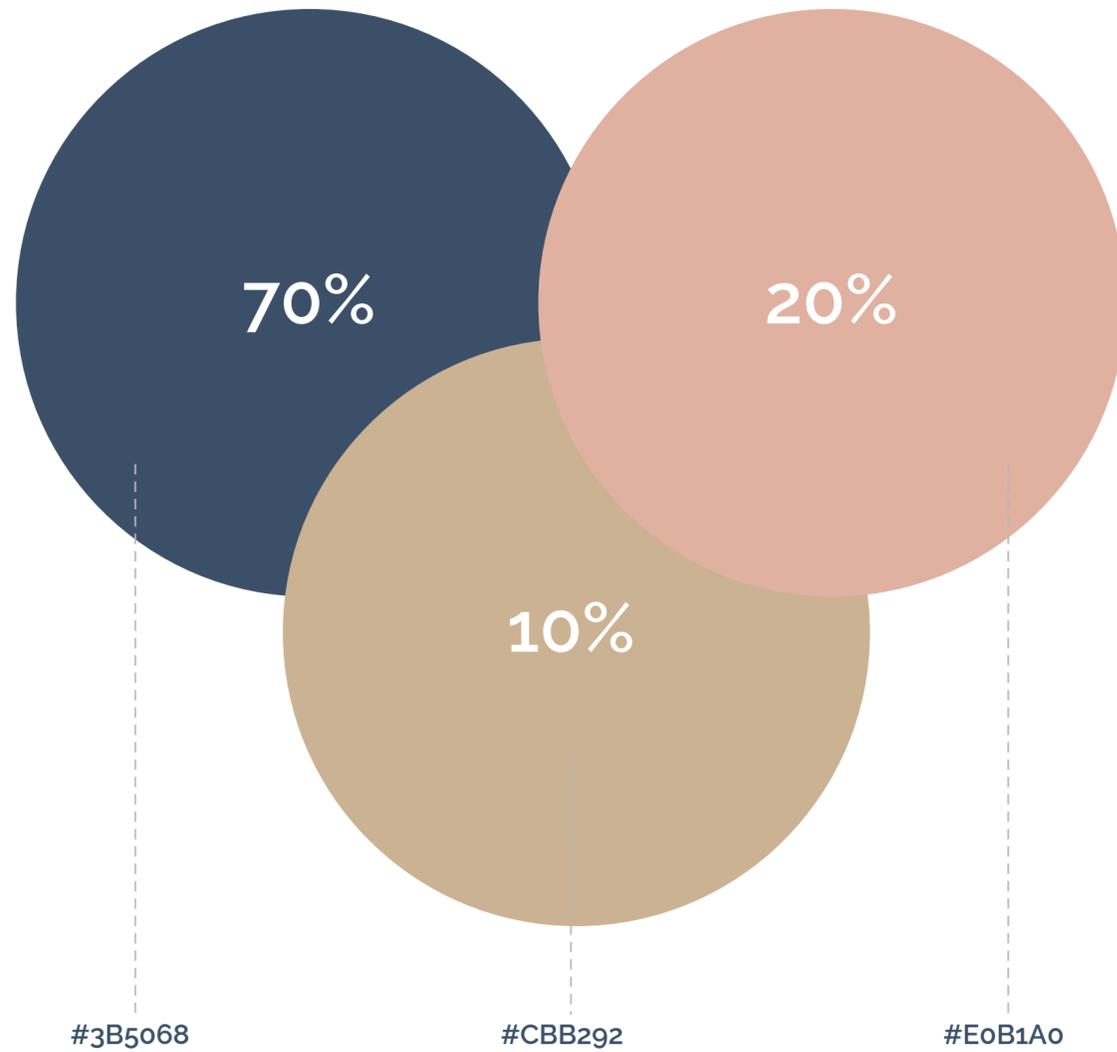

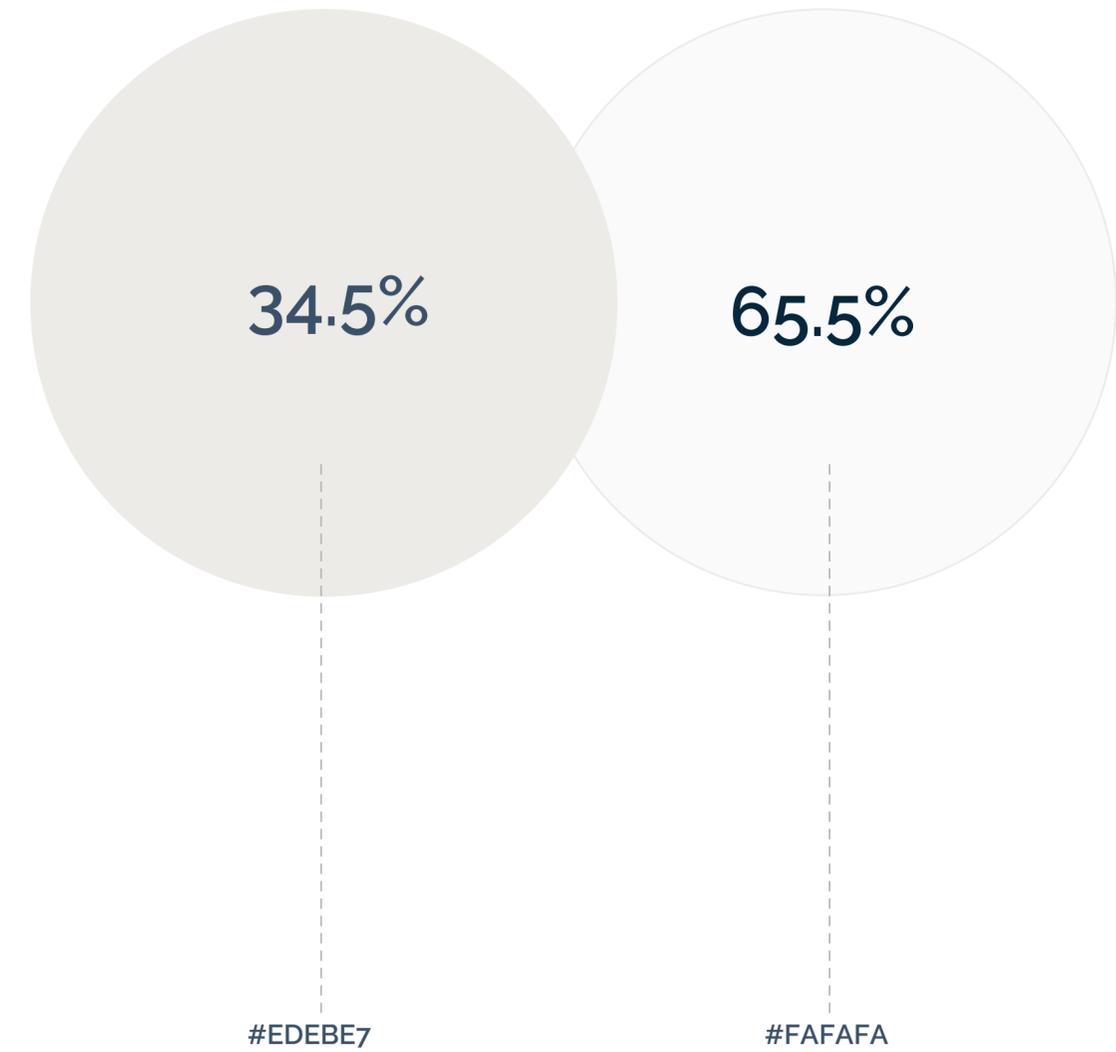

Noto Serif Display

Noto is a global font collection for writing in all modern and ancient languages. Noto Serif Display is a modulated ("serif") design for texts in larger font sizes in the European Latin script and in Cyrillic, Greek. Noto fonts are intended to be visually harmonious across multiple languages, with compatible heights and stroke thicknesses.

Raleway

Raleway is an elegant sans-serif typeface, designed in a single thin weight. It is a display face that features both old style and lining numerals, standard and discretionary ligatures, a pretty complete set of diacritics, as well as a stylistic alternate inspired by more geometric sans-serif typefaces than its neo-grotesque inspired default character set.

When structuring your content, keep in mind the order that you'd like your audience to read the information. Below is a good example of successful hierarchy, however you can mix this up a little bit and still be user friendly. For example, leaving negative space around a line of type or a higher contrasting colour will draw your reader's eye. A word of caution, please remember that if all of the type is shouting (ie. large and bold) then none is, as it will all blend together visually. It's important to vary the size and weight of your text.
